

## RESOLUTIONS AT ALL INDIA LEVEL



### AIFCEEEOA 1st FEC at Bhubaneswar on 23.7.2004

1. RESOLUTION No 1. Pay revision w.e.f 1.1.1996, with out arrears and the efforts of COC had been appreciated. Regarding merger, the President explained that it is our own demand.
2. RESOLUTION No 2. A committee was formed with all the four Joint Secretaries and with Shri S L Devangan as it's Chairman to find out the best possible modalities for implementation of All India Seniority and Merger of posts of PO,EO & Inspector.
3. RESOLUTION No 3. Anti-Staff attitude of Administration in Coimbatore.
4. RESOLUTION No 4. Abolition of Uniform for Central Excise & Service Tax work and to maintain uniform for Customs work with enhanced allowance.
5. RESOLUTION No 5. Stifling of democratic functions and flouting organizational discipline by any individual office bearer or unit. The letter of intent for attending the convention should reach the President 25.7.2004 from the concerned and thereafter the President & Secretary General should decide and undertake such measures as to pre-schedule the convention and hold it at a place and time in which all units could participate.

### AIFCEEEOA FEC held at Chennai on 24<sup>th</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> Dec 2004

1. RESOLUTION No 1. The Federation strongly oppose the outsourcing of work related to Central Excise and Service Tax.
2. RESOLUTION No 2. Authorised the Secretary General to chalk out campaign / agaitation programme along with the COC and along with other sister concerned in the Dept on the issue of out sourcing.
3. RESOLUTION No 3. The FEC resolved to accept the merger of Cadres of Central Excise and Customs only if implemented from 1.1.1996. If not, delink the (feeder cadres) Customs & Central Excise Cadres up to the level of Joint Commissioner level for purpose of promotion.
4. RESOLUTION No 4. To hold next convention of Federation at Pune. Shri Harish Radhakrishnan was authorized to initiate all measures to arrange a joint meeting of President/Secretary General of both the federations.
5. RESOLUTION No 5. Local Travel Expenditure (LTE), is the actual expenditure incurred by an executive officers for official work. It is violation of equality as it is being

given to CBDT and not being given to CBEC. Demand LTE w.e.f it is being paid to CBDT.

6. **RESOLUTION No 6. It is resolved to demand status quo ante in r/o allowing ICT in Central Excise.**

AIFCEE OA Convention held at Pune on 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> Dec 2006

1. **RESOLUTION No 1. Resolved that the AICEIA shall be affiliated to the confederation of CG Employees and workers and the branches/circles of the AICEIA shall participate at the unit level (COC of CG Employees) and participate in the programmes of the confederation. Further resolved to participate in the strike call of the confederation notified for 14/12/2006 in such a manner as would be possible for each branch/circle considering the limited time available for preparation for participation in the manner of a strike.**
2. **RESOLUTION No 2. To urge the CBEC not to abolish the Ranges since service tax matters, audit complaints and monitoring of revenue paid. CENVAT utilized etc. is being dealt with by the Ranges.**
3. **RESOLUTION No 3. To oppose outsourcing in Service Tax Commissionerates, not to accept any more additional workload and to urge the CBEC to increase staff strength for handling the increased workload.**
4. **RESOLUTION No 4. To urge the CBEC to have unique GPF account numbers allotted to each and every Inspector so that problems of missing credits would be avoided when officers are trfd to places with in the charge of another PAO.**
5. **RESOLUTION No 5. To challenge the O.M. No.21011/1/2006-Estt.(A) of DOPT dated 28.03.2006 which states that 'the overall grading recorded in the ACR has also not to be changed in any way even after the expunction of the adverse remarks either fully or partially by the competent authority', as ultra-vires either in the High Court or through the Confederation or National JCM.**
6. **RESOLUTION No 6. Since postings are being done at ALL INDIA LEVEL at the time of recruitment, in order to avoid regional problems, to urge the CBEC to issue postings as per residential addresses of the candidates.**
7. **RESOLUTION No 7. To demand restoration of mutual transfer and inter-commissoinerate transfers considering the difficulties members are put to due to the withdrawal of the facility.**

8. **RESOLUTION No 8. To hold nationwide agitations against opening of LTU at Chennai and to chalk out programmes in consultation with other organizations in the COC of revenue.**
9. **RESOLUTION No 9. Resolved that all the existing Federating units shall notify to the local administration the change in their status as Branches/Circles of the AICEIA as per the amendment to the constitution.**
10. **RESOLUTION No 10. Resolved to urge the Ministry/CBEC to grant recognition for this Association immediately since this Association has fulfilled the obligations and requirements as stipulated by the CCS(RSA) Rules, 1993 and the constitutional rights of the members cannot be denied by delay in recognition.**

1. **Stop outsourcing / contractorisation/downsizing.**

4. **Give effect to the revised pay for Inspectors of central Excise from 1.1.1996.**
5. **Stop discrimination between promotees and Drs in the ACP scheme and permit anomaly claims of seniors when juniors draw higher scale of pay.**
6. **Provide infrastructure in terms of work place, equipments, etc. in the field for executive work.**
7. **Grant Local Travel Expenses for Inspectors on par with Inspectors of Income Tax.**
8. **Grant Rummaging allowance for Officials posted in Customs area on par with the Officials of Customs.**
9. **Revise the ratio of promotions of Superintendents of Central Excise to Group 'A' as per the existing strength in Central Excise and Customs.**
10. **Create new posts of Assistant Commissioners for functional requirements.**

- 11. Strengthen Audit and Preventive wings in Central Excise and Customs and Audit and survey in Service Tax.**
- 12. Abolish Control Room and Uniform for Central Excise and Service Tax.**
- 13. Grant adequate uniform allowance for three sets of uniform for Customs work**
- 14. Notify the duty list of Inspectors of Central Excise.**
- 15. Provide necessary training and incentives to staff to enable Computerisation of the department in a full-fledged manner.**
- 16. Conduct Cadre Review immediately in CBEC.**
- 17. Declare Inspectors of Central Excise as Group 'B' Non-Gazetted as required by the CCS (CCA) Rules.**
- 18. Grant recognition for AICEIA immediately.**
